




A PROVEN TRACK RECORD OF GETTING GEAR TO KIDS

GOVERNANCE

Cleats for Kids and C4K are Federally registed trademarks of TO BY FOR KIDS FOUNDATION (Foundation), an Oklahoma not-for-profit corporation. The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization and its tax identification number is 45-3590945.

The Foundation is governed by an independent Board of community partners and leaders with approximately 15 members, Board committees, and an executive director and staff. The Board has established certain advisory boards including the Varsity Board (High School), Junior Varsity Board (Middle School), and Young Professional Board.

The Foundation adheres to written Bylaws, Code of Conduct, policies, procedures and Board resolutions. The Foundation engages independent third parties to perform day-to-day accounting and bookkeeping periodic reporting and tax preparation and filing (including the annual Form 990). The Foundation engages a separate firm to conduct an annual audit of its financials, inventory, and controls.

The Foundation operates across the state of Oklahoma and in the greater Cincinatti, Ohio area.
